# Summer Reading Program 2017: "Reading By Design" Instructions for Kids

## SIGNING UP

Between June 10<sup>th</sup> and August 19<sup>th</sup>, caregivers can either sign up their families online through the Bookpoints website, <a href="http://site07.readingbydesign.org/">http://site07.readingbydesign.org/</a>, or on paper at the Fort Bragg Library. Then they may continue online and/or on paper. The first 60 kids between the ages of 5 and 12 to sign up will get a ticket to Legoland!

## **READING LOGS**

There are two kinds of reading logs: pre-reader "Read with Me" logs and Reader logs. The recommended ages are 0 to 4 for "Read with Me" and 5 to 12 for Readers, but the caregiver or child can decide which log is a better match. (Some preteens may prefer the Teen reading log.)

For all kids, keep track of how much reading time they do after signing up. Everyone starts at Level 1, with zero minutes of reading. There are ten levels total, although not every level will have a prize. Total reading time for pre-readers is 300 minutes, or 270 if they also complete an activity. (The activity is either coloring the picture of Little Elliot the Elephant on the log OR attending a library program.) For readers, it's 600 minutes. Pre-readers, for every 30 minutes that they read, can color in or cross out a square with a dwelling in it. (Each of these counts as a level.) Readers will cross out a circle in the reading log for every 6 minutes of reading, so each row equals 60 minutes, or an hour. Each row of circles is a level, except for Level 10, which is two rows and counts for two hours.

## WHAT'S NEXT AFTER FINISHING A READING LOG?

You can keep reading but there won't be any more prizes, except for raffle prizes for those who signed up as readers rather than pre-readers.
