

# Summer Reading 2017: “Reading By Design”

## Instructions for Teens

### SIGNING UP

Teens can sign up anytime between June 10<sup>th</sup> – Aug 19<sup>th</sup>, either online through the Bookpoints website, <http://site07.readingbydesign.org/>, or on paper at the Fort Bragg Library. Then they may continue online and/or on paper. If they’re 11 or 12, they may be eligible for tickets to Legoland! Teens can do the reading logs and/or bingo cards.

### READING LOGS

Use the reading log to keep track of the books you read and the activities you complete, with at least five books, for a total of ten. (An activity is attending a teen-specific library event: Dungeons & Dragons Club, Teen Movie, or Teen Lock-In. This activity will count differently on the bingo card.) Each book or activity counts as a level, for ten levels total. You can do another reading log just for fun, but you won’t win anything extra.

### PRIZES FOR READING LOGS

Level 2	C.V. Starr Community Center Daily drop-in pass
Level 5	Coloring/origami book
Level 7	Coupon for Cowlick’s Ice Cream Café
Level 10	Book

Also, you’ll receive online raffle tickets along the way.

### BINGO

Teens that complete 5 SQUARES on a bingo card will be eligible to win weekly prizes. (The squares don’t have to be next to each other.) You can get BINGO when you complete ALL THE SQUARES on the bingo card, which gives you another chance at the raffle. Play more than once!
